## **Board of Trustee Interviews**

Senior students were charged with interviewing current Board of Trustee members to find out about their roles and responsibilities as a Board of Trustees member. The articles below are the result of the interviews.

This is Kathryn Anderson. Kathryn is a member of the B.O.T, or Board Of Trustees. It is her 8th year here, and she lives in Karori. She interviews new staff for Clyde Quay School (CQS). She manages purchases of stationery, new furniture and equipment for Pikopiko Kindergarten. "My job involves a monthly board meeting, sub committee meetings, paperwork, and actioning tasks," she said. Kathryn is the Queen Of the Kindergarten. She has taught nearly 60 percent of the students in CQS, and knows many of our families. "My favourite part of being on the B.O.T is the opportunity to give back to the school, staff and community," Kathryn says.





Hello, my name is Thorsten Engel. I am the Chair for the Board of Trustees (B.O.T), and my son is currently in Karaka. I set the agendas, sign off legal documents and I am the 'Complaint Manager' for the B.O.T. Three years ago, I supported the change in the school curriculum to include more maths and science. We make sure that students have enough chrome books, and we are currently working on recruiting more teacher aides and getting enough teachers to teach our children well. I am a consultant, and do my job on the B.O.T as well as my regular day job. The best part for me of being on the B.O.T is being able to help solve problems, and shape where the school invests. We

are currently looking at I.T, like trying to get more chrome books for the school. Most of the members of the B.O.T are new, and it is really nice to get to know lots of the parents at school and members of the community.
