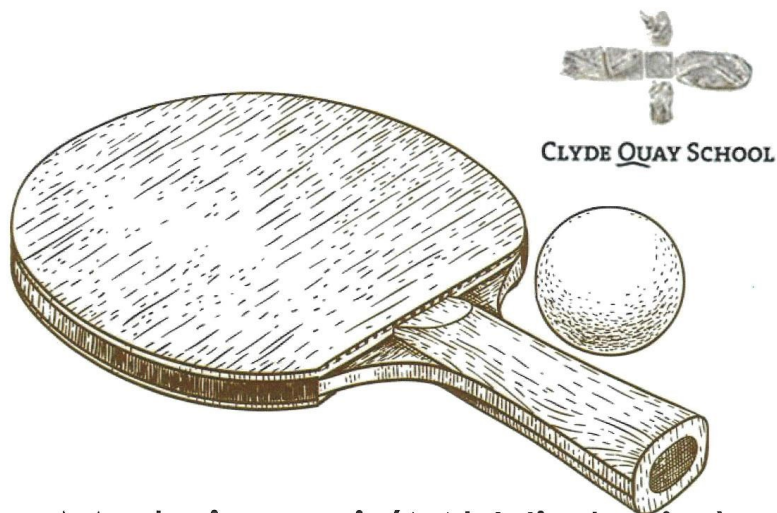
It was a great night to reconnect with parents, whānau, friends and staff and to make new friends.
