

Kiwi Competitions

The Kiwi competitions have been compiled by Canterbury University. It is the 'Centre of Assessment Monitoring' (CAM). The annual CAM Great Kiwi Science, English and Mathematics competitions are skills-based and closely aligned with the New Zealand Curriculum. The tests are designed by New Zealand teachers for New Zealand students.

Matairangi CQS had Y5-8 students participating in science, mathematics, and English. There were 13 of our students who registered for one and most for two or three subject areas. There are four grades of awards: participation, achieved, merit, and outstanding.
