"Yesterday Harakeke and Pohutukawa went to the Island Bay Marine Education Centre to kick off their Rocky Shore Inquiry. It was a total success - all the students were very engaged and their behaviour was amazing. Us teachers can't wait to hear about all the things our students noticed, and what curious questions they have that we can investigate.



Also, for any families that are interested, the Island Bay Marine Education Centre is now open every Sunday from 10am until 3pm. The touch pools are amazing, and as of today, a new Octopus has just joined the team for the next 6 months!"

At the reserve we were allowed to gently touch and hold many different sea creatures.

There were Sea Cucumbers which were very slimy (we were told by the marine biologist that they have gills in their bum; which is very unusual), Cushion Starfish, Snake Starfish which have long, spindly legs. If their legs get eaten they grow new ones, (when you looked closely you could see where the new legs had grown back), Sea Anenomes, and Hermit Crabs (which would duck into their shell when you turned them over) just to name a few.

And I really want monkey bars, I like to be like a monkey.


